ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

EDUCATION: High school diploma plus a minimum of Grade II Certification of Water Treatment. An Associate or Bachelor Degree is a plus. A Grade IV Certification of Water Treatment is a plus.

EXPERIENCE: Minimum of three years of experience in a Water Treatment Plant.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES, SKILLS:

The Water Treatment Plant Operator must have experience in the process, compliance, and operations of a water treatment plant.

The Water Treatment Plant Operator must possess strong organizational skills that reflect his/her ability to perform and prioritize multiple tasks seamlessly with excellent attention to detail.

The Water Treatment Plant Operator will be in a dynamic position which requires the ability to anticipate needs, think critically, and offer solutions quickly and with a high level of professionalism.

The Water Treatment Plant Operator will be a highly resourceful team-player who is self-motivated and actively seeks opportunities.

<u>WORK ENVIRONMENT:</u> While performing the duties of this job the majority of the time the Water Treatment Plant Operator is at desk or in the plant in a controlled environment.
