

Equipment Operator Position Needed – CDL required

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:** An employee in this class is responsible for the installation, service and repair of the water system; outdoors 90% of the time and must be willing to work non-standard hours and weekends. Work is performed in accordance with established policies and procedures under the general supervision of a Crew Chief. An equipment operator must lift items weighing over 40 pounds and be on 24hour call duty one week every four weeks.

**ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE WORK:** Thorough knowledge of geography, street locations, and numbering systems of the county and of the water system; thorough knowledge of the methods, materials, tools, and equipment used in installing, maintaining, and repairing water systems; thorough knowledge of all West Morgan East Lawrence Water & Sewer Authority's safety rules, policies, and procedures; ability to write legibly and keep simple records; ability to make arithmetical calculations rapidly and accurately; ability to operate heavy equipment; ability to understand and carry out written and oral instructions; ability to work under dangerous conditions; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with customers, other employees and the general public. Must possess a Grade I water Certification issued by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management within a timely manner.
