

Field Superintendent – City of Phenix City

This position oversees the daily operations of the water distribution and wastewater collection divisions. Schedules and follows up on repairs and installations of water and wastewater lines and services, schedules and arranges new installations and training for work crews; writes instructions and holds group meetings to explain plans; organizes worksite for installation or repair operations and inspects completed projects to ensure compliance with specifications; collects water samples for testing by laboratory. Interviews, orients and trains employees, approves and schedules leave time, counsels employees on work related issues and rates performance and performs additional tasks in support of the department as needed or upon request.

Requirements: Must have high school diploma or G.E.D equivalent; must have valid driver's license from state of residence; Five years prior utility construction experience mandatory; Water distribution and wastewater collection design and operations including installation and maintenance of water and wastewater mains, service lines, lift stations and pump stations. Operate various tools and equipment including backhoes, excavator, chainsaw and jackhammer; Develops plans for installation of new water and sanitary mains and services Locate and mark underground water and wastewater pipes; must have Wastewater Grade IC & Water Grade I Classifications by A.D.E.M.

Physical Requirements: Must possess manual dexterity to use a variety of hand tools; must have mechanical inclination to operate various machines and/or equipment; must be agile enough to work in all areas including uneven terrain; must see well enough to read fine print and numbers without error or transposition; must be strong enough to lift up to 75 lbs.
