

Wastewater Collections Supervisor – City of Phenix City

This position inspects equipment to ensure signaling and safety equipment is operable, checks for proper fluid levels, reports major equipment malfunctions to superintendent, operates various pieces of equipment to complete repair and construction; gathers materials, equipment and tools needed to perform tasks; ensures that crews have necessary safety equipment/items and are properly utilizing safety equipment and proper safety measures; supervises and coordinates work crews, make work assignments for workers and oversees installation and repairs; resolves minor work related problem and performs additional tasks in support of the department as needed or upon request.

Requirements: Must have high school diploma or G.E.D equivalent or demonstrated level of proficiency; must have valid Class B CDL from state of residence; previous experience in commercial laying of sanitary sewer lines and previous supervisory experience. Sanitary sewer systems including lift stations; Proper installation/repair of sanitary sewer pipe; Various types of pipe including PVC, ductile iron and concrete Asphalt cut/repair; operate various equipment including but not limited to mowers, backhoes, vac truck, dump truck, crane truck, mini excavator and excavator. Must possess ADEM Grade IC Wastewater Certification (obtained within one year of hire, grade assignment of SM-6 until certification is obtained).

Physical Requirements: Must possess manual dexterity to use a variety of hand tools; must have mechanical inclination to operate various machines and/or equipment; must be agile enough to work in all areas including uneven terrain; must see well enough to read fine print and numbers without error or transposition; must be strong enough to lift up to 75 lbs.
